Present Continuous

To talk about things that are happening now

You can use the present continuous to describe events and actions that are happening at this moment

Examples:-

- She is eating dinner right now and cannot answer the phone
- They are not watching TV at the moment
- He is studying a new language at the moment

Words that sometimes come in sentences with present continuous tense:-

- At the moment
- Now
- Today
- this week
- This month

Affirmative:-

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He
She + is + V. (ing)
It
```

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They
We + are + V. (ing)
You
I + am + V. (ing)
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Negative:-

am

Ex:- she is not reading this book.

They are not reading the book

I'm not reading the book

Question:-

am

is

Is he playing basketball?

- yes, he is.
- No, he isn't.

Are they writing the letter?

- Yes, they are.
- No, they aren't.

Is Noor crying now?

- Yes, she is.
- No, she isn't.

QUESTION WORDS



Usage: used to ask the person who did the action.

- **Examples:**
- · Who is the Present of Brazil?
- Who will be the winner?



Usage: used to ask for information.

- Examples:
- · What does this sentence mean?
- · What dress are you wearing tonight?



Usage: used to ask the time of an event/action.

- **Examples:**
- · When can I see you again?
- · When is the next World Cup?



Usage: used to ask for the location.

- **Examples:**
- · Where were the keys?
- · Where do you live?





Usage: used to ask for a reason/cause.

- **Examples:**
- · Why did you break the glass?
- · Why haven't you called?



Usage: used when there is a choice.

- Examples:
- · Which of these pens is the best?
- · Which author do you enjoy?



Usage: used to show possession.

- **Examples:**
- · Whose child is this that has a cough?
 - · Whose bag is this?



Usage: used to explain a process.

- Examples:
- · How do you learn English?
- · How has the weather been?
